MEPSA is an open, photo show organization. You do not need to pay any membership fees to show.

No registration needed. Just send your model photos, return envelope and your show fee, and you will be competing with some of the best. Not quite there yet? MEPSA also has a Novice division, designed to help coach new MEPSA showers to reach the level they need to compete in the open division! Reminders for judges!

The revised judge's packet has been streamlined so it is easy to read and it should answer any questions you might have. In addition, there is a check list to make sure you don't forget anything important. When you complete your checklist and submit it to the Judge coordinator (Linda) you will be entered in the annual drawing for an outstanding prize. It is important to complete your show (judging and submitting results and entry fees collected) in the time allowed.

If you are judging a specialty qualifier you probably will have fewer classes with more entries in them. For example, in the light breed special, stock classes will have 0 entrants. Feel free to split classes with high numbers of entries.

The contest is over as of the end of 2014. Pictures of the customized Adios models will be on the MEPSA blog and we will be asking you to vote for favorites in various categories. Novice class list (limit 15 photos. Each will receive an individual critique):

Each model/photo may enter 1 gender and 1 breed type class. Specify the breed of your model.

There is a maximum of two years allowed for novice showers, *unless* you are under 16 years old at the end of the second year. If most of the judges recommend you move to open, you may get early graduation after just one year. Graduation is mandatory, but we will consider an appeal if you feel you would benefit from a second year in novice.

SHOW FEES:

You can pay using <u>Paypal</u> for your show fees **mepsa2@hotmail.com**, but you MUST use the Personal Payment option or You will be responsible for any transaction fees. Prepaid Show coupons for MEPSA Qualifier entry!


Nervous about sending cash through the mail? For your convenience, you can now send one check or paypal payment to Robin Nere (esteemed treasurer) and receive coupons for show entry! Cash equivalent Coupons will be available in \$2 and \$5 denominations (combine 2 for a \$4 entry). You may receive your coupons electronically or by mail. Each will have a serial number so they can only be used one time. Simply enclose the value needed in place of cash or check in your entry. For example: for 100 halter photos, enclose two \$2 coupons. No more cash in the mail, no more check fees – entering shows just got easier!

Tips for showers

Having trouble qualifying horses for the championship? Sometimes I look at the results and only two models qualified. I get a pack of photos back and look through and – yes I did send my latest photos, and they look good. What's wrong? Well, dear readers, there is nothing wrong. MEPSA is just that competitive. Classes are large and there are many beautiful horses. Small differences in photos can make the difference, so of course, keep experimenting with lighting, background, color ... But here's another tip: enter the specialty shows: they have some smaller classes. Also, china, AR and CM (basically anything other than OF) all have smaller classes, making it easier to qualify.

Make the Judge Happy!

Sort your photos, first by division, then into first class order. Judging is a lot of work and saving the judge from that first sort is a true act of kindness. I find sorting between classes to be the most tedious (my back complains, and I'm really glad when it is over and I can get back to the fun of judging). It helps to **Design your photo back** to make sorting easy for the judge. Below is an excellent example. Of course, you can also include reference material and detailed make info (OF release or artists involved in AR/CM).



If you move, make sure to update your return address. This will help a wayward photo find its way home, as they do sometimes wander after a show! Having a consistent visual identifier is not required, but helps the judge on that last sort of your photos into your return envelope. For unusual breeds, you can help the judge by including a reference photo as part of your photo back (not a separate photo or sheet please) along with limited text or a link. And for rare models, you may place better in collectability if the judge knows there were only 5 made, for example.
