For those of you attending your first MEPSA championship show, you may be wondering when you can expect to see the results. The judging will probably be complete by August. I think you will be very pleased.

Holy Cow it's time to start prepping photos for the first shows of next season. As you go through your photos – please pull any that have digital editing, such as a clone tool used to remove elements/ smooth foreground/background transition, remove model stands or that sort of thing. It has been noticed by the judges that some photos appear to have been retouched in this way. **That is absolutely forbidden for photos being shown in MEPSA.** Go back to your original

untouched images and reprint or take some new photos over the summer. We will be sending out warnings if we continue to get reports from our judges re photos that appear to be altered. We don't want to disqualify any of your beautiful models. ☺ When labeling photos, make sure that your labels are legible and in a font plain and large enough for elderly/visually impaired judges (cause there are a lot of us!). Volunteering to judge is a huge commitment and we do not want our judges lives to be miserable.

She is also involved in pedigree assignment, IPABRA and the North American Model Arabian Horse Association.

Shana Bobbitt jumped in to assist with donor contests and has already shown herself to be indispensable.

The "election" is July 30. All nominees are running uncontested, so there will be no poll. If you do have a comment about any of these nominees, please email Carissa Kirksey, electoral secretary. The good news though is we were able to fill all offices with very high quality people! We can look forward to another successful MEPSA season.

Tweaks to the classlist for the 2018/19 season

Now that we have completed the Qualifier shows for the 2017/2018 season, it is time to look forward to the 2018/2019 season. I know that it took some time to get use to the new class list. Sometime ago, I asked the group how you felt about the list and if you wanted to see any possible changes. The consensus was that the majority of the class list is working, as is. However, we have decided to make a few changes. It should require a minimum of re-numbering. I made the following changes in the Other Breed Division:

- **Class 41 Feral/Semi-Feral Horse.** The class is now only for horses. All Ponies have been moved to their respective classes in the Pony division. Mustangs still go here. (all except the domesticated Spanish Mustang breed).
- **Class 42 Light Carriage.** This class is mostly heavy Warmblood type horses that are generally used with lighter carts/carriages. Check the new Breed Directory to see which breeds go here.
- **Class 43. Heavy Carriage.** This is for the remaining harness breeds. This would be the draft type for wagons and such. Again, check the Breed Directory.
- **The Small Horse class** was discontinued and the breeds moved to the Other Pure class (not just for Lipizzaners anymore!)

Because of these changes, the Div. A gender descriptions have been modified as follows:

**Light Type: Arabian, Morgan, light type mixes and light mules, etc.*

**Sport/Light Carriage Type: Thoroughbred, Warmblood, Gelderlander, Cleveland Bay, sport/carriage type mixes, and sport/carriage mules, etc.*

**Spanish/Gaited Type: Andalusian, Pasos, American Saddlebred, Tennessee Walker, Spanish/gaited type mixes, and Spanish/gaited mules, etc.*

**Stock Type: Quarter Horse, Appaloosa, Paint, stock type mixes, and stock mules, etc.*

**Draft/Heavy Carriage Type: Belgian, Clydesdale, Shire, Gypsy Vanner, Irish Cob, draft/carriage type mixes and draft/carriage mules, etc.*

**Pony Type: Shetland, Welsh, Fjord, Miniature horses, pony type mixes and pony mules, etc.*

We have added a Headstudy class to the Halter class list in all divisions. It is still class 134 (no renumbering), but it will give Halter only showers a chance to show their Headstudys without entering the Performance shows. We also have removed the Headstudy classes from contention for any Championships.

In Division B, we added Bainbridge to class 74. Ceramics-Royal Worcester, Animal Artistry, Pour Horse, Bainbridge, and Horsing Around

In Performance, we have added the ability to show multiple entries in the Hunter Arena/Field, Pleasure/Fine Harness, and Other Harness classes. Two entries will be allowed per class, AS LONG AS THEY ARE OF DIFFERENT DISCIPLINES. **AND** the discipline must be listed by the shower **AND** the judge.

I have updated the dates in the Breyer Collectability division. Current as of 2018. Recent Discontinued 2002-2017 and Vintage Discontinued 2001 and before. This is where the most renumbering might take place, but that is normal every year as models are discontinued.

There were a few complaints, last year, from the judges about photos that did not have the correct class numbers. This is the perfect opportunity to check ALL of your photos and make sure they are entered in the correct classes. Just remember to check your Champ show photos when they come back, too! As for the breed classes, the Breed Directory is a guideline to use as to where each breed should go. However, you have the option to choose a different class if you wish. Keep in mind, though, that the judge has the final say in which class the model is judged in. Please do not put more than one class in each section (e.g. class 51 and/or class 52b for your roan sabino – just pick one)

RULES AND DEFINITIONS:

Mail-in entries only. Printed digital photos (with only cropping and color corrections made; no items added, changed, or deleted) and preferably 4X6 in size, may be entered. Online/emailed entries are not accepted. Please mark each photo with the appropriate division letter, the class number(s), the model's name, breed, gender and color, and your name, address and 5 letter code (1st two letters of your first name, 1st three letters of your last name). Collectability or Workmanship information is strongly encouraged. In Performance, please have a description of the entry, including any pattern or movement. A list of Current Breyers and a Breed Directory, indicating which class a specific breed is recommended to enter, are located on the website. Mixed breeds may enter whichever mixed class the owner feels is best for their model. One photo per class unless otherwise noted on class list. Classes with over 50 entries may be split at judge's discretion. Models that place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd (1st-6th in classes of 100 or more) qualify to enter the year-end MEPSA Championship Show! Entrants must keep track of their own qualifiers. SASE with adequate postage **required** for each show. Full results to all entrants. Make any checks payable to the judge. Here's the skinny on ... the MEPSA Judge rating system

In the world of MEPSA we strive for greatness when it comes to our judges. We try to recruit new judges but also bring back judges year after year. Over the years, there have been some rough shows, so we put a rating system in place for the shower's protection. We all know how expensive this hobby can be, and MEPSA wants to make sure that we keep judges that are in good standing. Starting in the 2018-2019 show season we plan to recognize the judges who really shine and make MEPSA a great place to photo show.

Here is the breakdown of how we rate a judge:

Judges get credit for:

- Completing the show in the time within 4 weeks - this means judging and sending the results to the entrants either digitally, or through snail mail, whichever the entrant chooses.
- Filing the paperwork within 4 weeks – with each show, the judge is sent a Judge's Packet. In the packet is a worksheet that needs to be filled out and e-mailed or s-mailed to the MEPSA Treasurer.
- Sends show proceeds to the Treasurer
- Returning photos to the entrants
- E-mailing the results to the Webmistress for posting on the MEPSA website.

Generally, accomplishing this will earn an A rating.

And lose credit for:

- Poor communication. *MEPSA recognizes that emergencies occur. Illness, disaster, Death in the Family – we recognize that things happen, and are **prepared to assist**. The important thing is that the judge lets us know how things are going, and requests help as early as possible.*

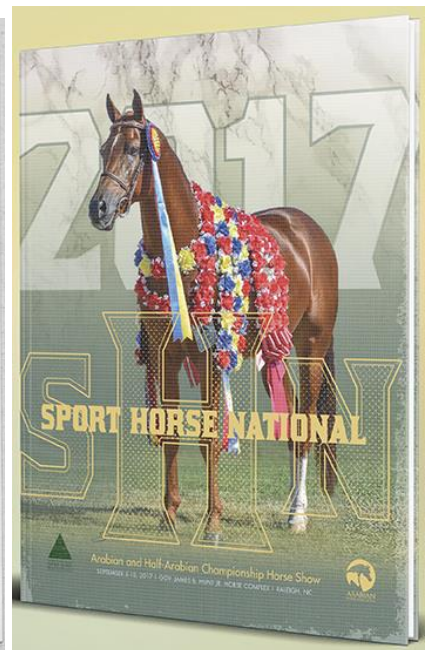
- Requires assistance – needing help to finish judging, type digital results, or return photos. Ideally we need judges that can do these things.

Extra credit – Speed! Yep, it’s a “speed game”

- Get ‘er done in 3 weeks – will generally net you a AA rating
- Get ‘er done in 2 weeks or less – will generally net you a AAA rating.

Are we just old? We have had judging trauma over the years, but we (the board) quickly forget the actual details. And we want to ensure that MEPSA showers have a “safe” showing environment, with high quality judging, while at the same time caring for the judges that provide us such a generous service. Rating our judges allows us to keep records of judging history, and bring back reliable judges year after year.

Let me emphasize that this is not a competition between judges, but just a way of storing information to supplement our feeble brains. MEPSA appreciates ALL of our judges, and all that complete their shows successful are entered into the annual judges drawing for a fine prize.
